'We have a working knowledge of cosmetic medicine and often work with other health professionals such as cosmetic physicians, dermatologists, plastic and reconstructive surgeons. 'Unfortunately, Australia's industry is predominantly unregulated, with no formal guidelines or licences, so it's important clients understand the different qualifications and scope of treatments each practitioner can perform. This is especially important with advanced treatments such as we do. You have one skin and its care is important.'

Territory Laser Clinic's team are specifically trained to assist in the therapeutic and cosmetic application of skin treatments and non-surgical rejuvenation. 'Our 7th Generation VISIA Complexion Analysis System, the only one in the Territory, provides a comprehensive view of your skin's health — its texture, pores, red areas, UV spots, wrinkles and acne bacterial excretions. Its in-depth report allows us to devise individual treatment plans to gain the best possible result for the client.'

'Not everyone has major skin issues. We've treated patients ranging from 9 to 86 years of age. During consultations, we take our time — planning and explaining the various options to suit their means and lifestyle and ensuring they will be comfortable with the outcome. We're a results-oriented clinic. It's important clients feel amazing in the skin they're in.'
