Unique upcycling doesn't even begin to describe Karl Hell's stunning Acacia Hills home.

'The kitchen needed to tie in with the timber floors, which were milled from old railway sleepers that are 50-100 years old,' Karl says. Mario Tsirbas from 4Kitchens crafted the benchtops from solid African mahogany timber reclaimed by Karl, and offset this with the brand-new oxidised steel look of Deckton Trilium for the splashbacks. The Ultraglaze Lava Gloss cabinetry gives the kitchen context, reflecting the timber rather than competing with it.

'Mario turned our vision into a reality and blended everything beautifully,' Karl says.

Allcraft Cabinet Works never shy away from cabinetry projects on a budget, however the centrepiece of this home is where the design team at Allcraft Cabinet Works really delivered. The wood panelling laminate in Belgium oak finish was selected to contrast with the more neutral palette across the rest of the floor, adding coziness and a warmth, drawing you to it, to be nourished and replenished. Seamless doors, devoid of handles, allow the eye to drift around the space. The wrought iron-look faucet stands proud, as the giver of life should. With the butler's pantry hidden in this design, Allcraft Cabinet Works stands out again.



Unifying three different types of finish to harmonise and achieve a united purpose is a craft, and Allcraft Cabinet Works deserve their name.

'I wanted the kitchen to be different, a showpiece, like my cooking - something special,' explains owner Artemis Bandes. The textured light hue of the woodgrain cupboards and island bench front give a sense of craft and form, while the hi-shine dark grey laminate evokes structure and strength, balanced with the concrete bench you would think was a composite finish. George Loannou from Allcraft used his 3D graphic design software to create a visualisation of the end result so the owner could get a feel for how the layout would work for them.

'It was exciting seeing the 3D images. I admit I was initially scared it was too dark, but George assured me it would work and it has. I couldn't be happier,' continues Artemis. 'It's stunning and everyone else loves it too.'
