For International House Business College Darwin CBD campus, all the internal fit-out, gyprocking, toilets, electrical, data, mechanical, fire installations and upgrades, 10 classrooms and an external building facelift.

The Darwin Golf Club’s new gaming room involved a full internal and general carpentry fit-out, specialised

timber finishes, architectural coffered ceilings, decorative screening and an outdoor area.

At the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel Alice Springs, the demolition, refurbishment of 235 rooms, fully fitted out with bespoke cabinetry, bathrooms with stone vanities, and loose furniture installed.

The Hilton Darwin’s lobby, new PerryBerry restaurant and Palm Court Bar & Lounge are BTC’s craftsmanship. They manufactured, supplied and installed all the custom banquette seating and provided the placement of loose furniture.
